

## Lace and Cables Cap

Well it's finally fall, with the barest hint of a chill in the air. Not really cold enough for a winter hat but cool enough for something. How about a lacy skull cap?

Quick and easy. Check. A stash buster, perhaps? Sweet.

This one used some leftover Knit Picks Gloss and US3s.

## The specs...

Yarn: 50g fingering weight
Gauge: 7sts = 1 inch in stockinette stitch
Fit: average woman's head

## Get started...

CO 120 and knit 1 round Work the main chart for 4 inches, ending on row 2 (more if you'd like more ear coverage)
chart key

| $\square$ | knit |
| :--- | :--- |
| - | purl |
| O | YO |
| Y | K2tog |
| $\lambda$ | SSK |

C4B SI 2 to CN, hold to back, K2, K2 from CN

Main Chart (rep. 12x ending on row 2)


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## Now decrease...

Follow the Decrease Chart until 12 stitches remain.
K2tog around, then cut the yarn leaving enough tail to weave through the remaining 6 stitches. Pull the top closed and block.

Decrease Chart (rep. 4x)
